How to open the ReNuSurface 5-gallon Carboy container

The following instructions will assist you in opening a new Carboy. The opening is $\frac{3}{4}$ " in diameter. You will need a cordless drill or socket extender with that diameter. Please remember to exercise caution when using tools to open a Carboy. Also, be sure to wear the appropriate safety equipment.

Place the Carboy on a flat surface at an appropriate height for you to be able to use your cordless drill or socket extender in a safe manner. Place the Carboy in a location, or at a safe distance, from anything that could be damaged if you were to accidentally tip over the Carboy while opening the container. Proceed with one of the following opening options:

Option 1. Using a cordless drill with a $\frac{3}{4}$ " Spade/Paddle drill bit or a hole saw bit, drill out the Carboy opening. It is okay if the inner piece of plastic falls into the Carboy.

Option 2. Using a blunt $\frac{3}{4}$ " socket extender, hammer the socket extender into the Carboy opening until the inner section gives way. Be careful not to drop the socket extender you are using into the Carboy. Again, it is okay if the inner plastic piece falls into the Carboy.

Turn the vent cap counter clockwise prior to dispensing product.
